I. ABOUT THIS ABSTRACT

An abstract should be prepared as the following: (1) The abstract should not exceed two pages in A4. (2) This format is based on *revtex*. (3) References should be indicated in the text in square brackets, such as [1] and listed at the end of the abstract. (4) Figures should be high quality graphics, line drawings, or black and white photographs. (5) Acknowledgement should be placed as a last paragraph of the main text.

If you do not use LaTex, any editor can be used as long as the submitted abstract is a PDF in a similar style.
